Best of '72

Macon's Steiner, Lakeside's Johnson, Chamblee's Spiva at Head of Class in AAA

When Godfrey "Goot" Steiner looked at what he had to work with at the start of this football season, he reasoned that he would be happy if Central-Macon won as many as seven games.
So, after 14 weeks of playing, Steiner had coached his team into a spot in the finals of the state playoffs in Class AAA, with almost twice that many wins.
That says a lot for the team. But it also says a lot for the kind of coach Steiner is. And he's the kind of coach that can be named the Journal-Constitution's Coach of the Year in Class AAA.

Mike Johnson and Andy Spiva join Steiner as the back and lineman singled out for best of the year honors. Johnson, a quarterback at Lakeside High School, and Spiva, a linebacker at Chamblee, pace the Journal-Constitution's AAA All-State team.
Steiner's Central-Macon team paces the all-state team number-wise with four representatives. Lakeside has two, as does Douglas Co., Valdosta, Moultrie and Griffin.
Johnson led Lakeside into a spot in the state finals on the strength of his passing arm and quick feet. He hit of 117 passes for 1,403 yards, ran for 334 more, and punted for a 41.6-yard average. He threw 15 touchdown passes.
Spiva anchored Chamblee's defense in amazing fashion. He averaged 14.7 tackles per game, intercepted three passes,

recovered six fumbles, kicked two field goals, and seven extra points.
Central-Macon's leading running back and a member of the all-state team is Al Pollard. The fullback ran for over 1,000 yards, for a 5.82 average, and scored 10 touchdowns.
Joining Pollard as Central-Macon members of the team were Neil Callaway, a linebacker, punter Dennis Barbare and placekicker David Taylor. Callaway graded over 80 per cent both as a linebacker and a guard for Central this year, and was called "the best football player I have ever coached" by Steiner.
Barbare and Taylor paced Central to an amazing kicking game. Barbare punted for a 41.52 average this season, and Taylor, only a sophomore, kicked 39 of 40 extra points. More importantly, though, were his three field goals, two of which won games for Central-Macon.

Ray Goff and Marty Hammock of Moultrie are also members of the all-state team. Goff led an offense that scored 40 points or more six straight times during the season. Hammock, a defensive back, was the backbone of Moultrie's defense.
Griffin's two members of the all-state team are Tony Head and Randy Pass. Head, as a halfback, ran for over 1,000 yards, scored 13 touchdowns, and had a 50-yard run to his credit. Pass, an offensive guard, graded 90 per cent as a blocker this season.
